

New graduate certificate offered in global health



The [Division of Public Health](#) in the [Department of Family and Preventive Medicine](#) is pleased to announce a new graduate certificate in global health. The division is accepting students into this certificate program immediately.

The Global Health Certificate prepares students to:

- Partner with other health professionals worldwide to tackle emerging global health issues
- Deal with health issues at home that have their origin from other countries and ensure that our population is protected with good health
- Learn from other health professionals across the world

The admission requirements for the Certificate in Global Health (CIGH) are:

1. Have an undergraduate degree from an accredited college
2. If not already enrolled in Graduate Program, apply online through the Graduate School <http://www.sa.utah.edu/admiss/>,
 - Under **Application Type** please select *Graduate* and
 - for **Intended Major** please select *Public Health MPH*
 - at the end of the application in the **comment box** please write/type add in ***Certificate of Global Health***.
3. Submit a letter of intent not to exceed 500 words (make sure you include your full name, contact information and student ID number)
4. After Courtney DeMond has received 2 & 3 we will set up a meeting to go over the classes and requirements.

Successful completion of the CIGH will require a minimum of 16 credit hours. 10 credits will be required coursework and at least 6 credits of approved electives.
